From the Desk of the University Fire Marshal

In conducting numerous training classes here at the University of Kentucky, when I ask "What should you do if you discover a fire?", I will almost always have someone say "Stop, Drop and Roll." I explain that is only if you are **on fire!** In talking with students I have learned that in most cases the only fire safety training they ever received was in elementary school.

I am a firm believer that if you have valuable information and present it in a way that is interesting, people will want to hear the message and will put the information to use. In 2010 my office trained over 13,000 students and over 2300 faculty and staff. This is an 86.88% increase

in training over 2009 numbers. We are proud of the number of people trained and we intend on increasing these numbers in 2011.



We give people knowledge about what to do if they discover a fire, how fast a fire can spread, how quickly they need to react, and what to do if they are trapped in a fire. History shows that a lot of people die in fires because they panic and are not prepared.

Society takes for granted that the

buildings and homes that they occupy are safe, or if they are involved in a fire situation that someone will tell them what to do. As I tell the students, "The only person you can depend on in a fire is yourself. Be aware of your surroundings. Have a plan and if the situation arises, be prepared to put your plan to use".

Fire/Life Safety training is vital to making the University of Kentucky a safer place to live.

⁽¹⁾ Fire Alarm System - Consists of a fire alarm control panel, pull stations, smoke detectors and interconnection with any required suppression system. All fire alarm systems are monitored and notify the required personnel upon activation of an alarm.

⁽²⁾ Sprinkler System - Water fire suppression systems. Upon activation, sounds an alarm in the facility affected and sends a signal to the monitoring company. The monitoring company notifies the required personnel.

⁽³⁾ Smoke Detectors - Smoke sensing devices installed in required locations. Sounds a local alarm in the facility affected.

Fire Drills

This is how we do them!



Each on-campus housing facility is required to have fire drills in accordance with the Fire/Life Safety Policy for On-Campus Student Housing http://ehs.uky.edu/ehs/docs/pdf/fs_life_safety_policy_08052010.pdf.

Part II, Section D, of the policy requires the following:

- I. Two fire drills shall be conducted during the Fall Semester. The first drill shall be an announced walk-through drill. The second drill shall be unannounced.

2. One unannounced drill shall be conducted during the Spring Semester
3. All fire drills shall be reported to the Office of the University Fire Marshal via the on-line fire drill report <http://ehs.uky.edu/ehs/fire/drill.html> within 48 hours of the event.

4. The fire alarm shall be utilized for each drill.
5. The Office of Residence Life shall schedule fire drills.

Part III, Section B, has all the same requirements as stated in Part II, Section D, with the exception being that the Dean of Students Office will schedule the drills for the on-campus Fraternities and Sororities.

Each facility listed on the Life Safety Equipment in Student Housing Facilities List (pages 2-4) is required to have fire drills. A record of each drill is kept on file in the Office of the University Fire Marshal.

For the year 2010, all Residence Halls, Apartments, Sororities, and Fraternities completed the required drills.

Electrical Appliances, Smoking and Open Flames

The University Fire/Life Safety Policy for On-Campus Student Housing

http://ehs.uky.edu/ehs/docs/pdf/fs_life_safety_policy_08052010.pdf contains information on electrical appliances, smoking and open flames.



Part I, Section E, is related to a student's room. In this section, students are informed that smoking is not permitted in any University building. Candles and incense (open flames) are not permitted in student housing.

Part I, Section F, is related to electrical issues. This section informs students that extension cords and multi-plug adaptors are not permitted in University housing, as well as how electrical equipment is to be maintained.

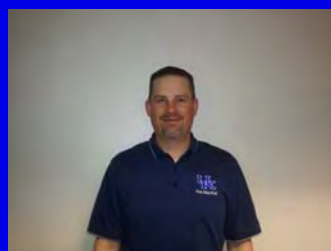
Section G, is related to appliances. This section bans the use of space heaters and halogen lamps. Microwave ovens are permitted as long as sufficient electrical current is available. All other cooking devices shall be located in a kitchen.

Evacuation Policy

The University has a mandatory evacuation policy

<http://ehs.uky.edu/ehs/fire/evacuation.html>. All students, faculty, and staff are required to immediately evacuate in the event of a fire alarm. This policy applies to all buildings at any time. The only exception to this policy is in patient related areas such as the University Hospital.

Any student that violates the evacuation policy is subject to disciplinary actions by the Dean of Students Office.

Utilizing the Building Emergency Action Plan (BEAP), the Hall Directors and Resident Advisors train occupants on the procedures for evacuation

Procedures include but are not limited to:

1. When the alarm sounds start evacuating immediately.
2. Make sure the fire is not outside your door.
3. Never go towards the smoke (find another way out).
4. Go to your assigned meeting location.
5. If you are trapped by the fire, call 911.
6. Report anyone that did not evacuate to your Resident Advisor or Hall Director.



Education and Training

All occupants living in on-campus housing are required to have fire/life safety training as outlined in the Fire/Life Safety Policy for On-Campus Student Housing http://ehs.uky.edu/ehs/docs/pdf/fs_life_safety_policy_08052010.pdf. All fire/life safety training is required to be

conducted or approved by the Office of the University Fire Marshal.

All Hall Directors and Resident Advisors are required to have fire and life safety training prior to students moving into the residence halls. Resident Advisors are required to complete a fire safety class within the first few weeks of each new school year.

Lexington Fire Department conduct training sessions throughout the University. T-shirt give aways, fire extinguisher training, and a smoke tent are set up at various locations. In 2010, 13,292 students participated in these sessions.

Students in randomly selected residence halls have fire drills using theatrical smoke. These drills provide students an opportunity to gain the understanding of what it is like in a real fire situation.



The President or designee of each Greek Organization is to ensure that all occupants read and understand the fire/life safety policy and to schedule a fire/life safety class within the first two weeks of each semester. Throughout the month of September, the Office of the University Fire Marshal and the

Who needs to know?

All University buildings have fire alarm systems that are monitored by a central station. When an alarm is activated, the central station automatically notifies the University Police Department (UKPD) and the Lexington Fire Department. Calling 911 is recommended after you have evacuated the building.

UKPD has a call tree for each type of facility. All essential personnel are notified by the UKPD dispatcher. Students only need to report the fire to UKPD via 911.
